U.S. SOCCER Y LA ASOCIACIÓN ESTATAL DE FLORIDA PRESENTAN CURSO "C" PARA ENTRENADORES DICTADO EN ESPAÑOL

CHICAGO (27 de noviembre, 2007) - La Federación de Soccer de Los Estados Unidos (USSF) y la Asociación Estatal de Florida (FYSA), anuncian que a partir del día 13 de marzo del 2008 se celebrará el Curso nacional para entrenadores de futbol categoría "C" en español. Éste es uno de los tres cursos nacionales más importantes que se están dictando en Estados Unidos, a la vez aprobado por la FIFA.

El curso tendrá lugar en el complejo deportivo de Central Park que esta localizado en 9151 NW 2nd ST. (Central Park Drive). La duración del curso "C" será de 90 horas, divididas en partes teóricas y prácticas. Los horarios para los 8 días serán desde las 9 a.m. hasta las 7:30 p.m. Las fechas designadas para éste curso serán las siguientes: 13 al 16 y 20 al 23 de marzo del 2008. Es obligatorio asistir las 90 horas del curso.

Esta Licencia "C" será coordinada por Juan Carlos Michia en representación de la USSF y FYSA. Los Coordinadores Nacionales de la Región II Roberto Lòpez y Región IV Rene Miramontes serán parte del grupo de instructores que dictaran este curso. Para más información, debe comunicarse con Juan Carlos vía email a jcmichia@ussoccer.org. El número de técnicos que serán aceptados es limitado, se ruega a los interesados que se inscriban lo más pronto posible para asegurar su asistencia en este curso.

Para poder tomar el Curso C en español se requiere que la persona sea mayor de 18 años y esté en posesión de la Licencia Nacional "D" por un mínimo de un año; o que haya sido jugador profesional y entrenador de futbol juvenil o profesional por un mínimo de tres años. Copias de la documentación comprobando su carrera como jugador y entrenador, incluyendo contratos o artículos como jugador profesional, serán requeridas por U.S. Soccer.

Por segunda vez en el Sur de la Florida se realizara un Curso "C" en español. Gracias al esfuerzo de FYSA se ha conseguido el permiso y el aval de la USSF para poder dictar este curso en esta parte del país. Esta es una oportunidad única para que nuestros técnicos puedan ampliar sus conocimientos futbolísticos sin tener que desplazarse a otros Estados de la Nación y de esa manera reducir los gastos asociados con los cursos nacionales.

National “C” License Course

The National “C” License is a nine day program that focuses on the principles of attacking and defending in small groups, up to 7v7. Candidates will be given opportunities during the week to watch and discuss soccer on the field and on the video screen.

Instructors will focus on getting the candidates to recognize the principles of soccer as they occur in the game and to get the candidates to give appropriate guidance and make appropriate adjustments to the players.

The course will also continue to emphasize the proper and effective use of the coaching methodology that was introduced in the “D” course.

Here are some examples of what is offered during the course:

- Candidates will be given opportunity to run two training sessions which finish in a 7v7 model. They are then provided feedback from U.S. National Staff Coaches
- U.S. National Staff Instructors conduct realistic training sessions throughout the course using methodology recognized by the U.S. Soccer Federation
- Classroom sessions involve active candidate participation and use game/training video as a learning tool
- Candidates are expected to be able to teach technique and how it is applied in a game environment. They should also have small group tactical ideas learned in the USSF “D” license course
- Pre-course material/reading is expected to be completed prior to arrival of the course. The USSF Best Practices manual is available online and candidates should be comfortable with the information before they arrive. Coaches should arrive fit and ready to actively participate the entire week
- Recommend that candidate have experience coaching 11-14 year old players prior to taking the course
- Oral exam questions will be given at the beginning of the course. Each coach will give a 3-5 minute oral presentation to the group at the end of the week

It is recommended that candidates run training sessions at home prior to taking the course. Candidates should have the training session evaluated by a club technical director and ask for feedback.

COURSE ELIGIBILITY

"C" LICENSE

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, and have earned a National "D" License certification held for a minimum of 12 months (attach a copy to application). "D" License certification may be waived under one of the following conditions:

- 1) Application received the NSCAA National Diploma and has held it for a minimum of 12 months.
- 2) Applicant has three (3) years coaching experience **AND** has three years playing experience with U.S. National Teams or three (3) years professional playing experience.

WAITING PERIOD: There is a mandatory waiting period of one (1) year between each level of license ("D" through "A").

EXAMINATIONS AND EVALUATIONS

Candidates undergo a challenging series of written, oral and practical examinations on a variety of subjects. Graded on a scale of 1 (high) to 5 (fail), candidates must receive passing scores in all test areas in order to become licensed. A single failing score in a theoretical subject qualifies for a re-test in that subject. All re-tests will take place at the conclusion of the course. A single failing score in either of the methodology subjects will result in a failing grade for the course with no re-testing. If a candidate is found deficient in only Game Awareness, he/she may still pass the course. *If an applicant misses any of the course sessions, he/she must return to a future school to participate in that session/lecture, even if the candidate has passed all of the testing areas. License will be withheld until this requirement is fulfilled.*

3.2 RULE

If "C" candidates receives a passing grade equaling 3.2 or above, they must wait two (2) years before attending a "B" course. However, if they audit a "B" course within that two-year period, they will be permitted to attempt the "B" License after the minimum 12-month waiting period.

Candidates will receive their results from the national office within 6-8 weeks following the conclusion of the course. Successful candidates will receive a license certificate and license card at that time.

NOTE: We strongly recommend that you be in "good" physical condition to meet the demands of the course.

DOCUMENTATION FOR WAIVERS

- 1) If applying as a professional player, applicant must submit proof, such as photocopies of contracts, or verification by owner on official team letterhead. Documentation of coaching experience is also required.
- 2) If application holds an NSCAA Diploma, a copy of the diploma must be attached to the application.

If required documents do not accompany application, it will be returned.
